All towns except Cambridge and Peterborough are treated as single entities

It would have been good to use the dwelling type mix to finesse the per-household indirect CO2, but source data for this isn't in the IZA report, only percentages that fall within 'high' and 'low' bands

Transport emissions are based on traffic miles on roads in the district, not the use by residents
